- Introductions (refer to sign-in sheet)
- Description of Work
 - Review drilling locations
 - Dane County interested in the water table and competent bedrock over the site. High water table was encountered in preliminary drilling work along the north, east, and central portions of the site and bedrock was encountered along the southern end of the site.
 - Drilling locations show non figures are approximate. All borings need to consider golf course operations, access, and overhead obstructions.
 - City of Madison communications
 - Field staked locations have been pre-approved by City golf course staff. Minor adjustments may be made pending approval from City golf course staff.
 - It's important that all drilling operations are cognizant of golf course operations and infrastructure (utilities, greens, tees, fairways, etc.). The golf course is anticipated to have 36 holes through 2024, 27 holes through 2025, and 18 holes until at least 2042.
 - Dane County, City of Madison, and the awarded drilling contractor must work in close coordination to minimize and/or mitigate any potential damage. A pre-construction meeting will be held in early December to plan access routes to each drilling location.
 - o Drilling methods: Hollow Stem Auger (Base Bid) or Sonic (Alternate Bid)
 - o All documents related to RFB 322035 are on the Dane County website for free dow nload.
- Schedule
 - Last day for Questions: October 14, 2022
 - Last day for Addendum: October 18, 2022
 - Bids Due: October 25, 2022 by 2 PM
 - Pre-Construction Meeting and Route Planning: December 1, 2022 (estimated)
 - Earliest Start Date Ground must be frozen (est. early Dec 2022).
 - Latest Start Date (est. January 15, 2023)
 - Substantial Completion by March 1, 2023 (est. liquidated damages \$1,000 per day)
 - Liquidated damages may be discussed during contract negotiations. Dane County may be open to having a bonus for timely completion as opposed to liquidated damages.

 - Bid Bond: 5% of maximum bid
 - <u>Best Value Contractor</u> Approval DUE PRIOR TO BID DUE DATE. <u>Note, Dane County will not</u> open bids from Contractors who are not BVC approved.

 - Dane County no longer requires Bidders to be a <u>paid registered vendor</u> with Dane County but is strongly encouraged
- Bid Opening on **TUESDAY**, **OCTOBER 25**, **2022** / **2:00 P.M** at the Waste & Renew ables Office, 1919 Alliant Energy Center Way, Madison WI 53713. Hard copies of bids must be delivered to the Waste & Renew ables Office. No electronic submittals or late bids will be accepted.
- Contract/Payment
 - Review the sample construction contract carefully as there are specific County requirements (Affirmative Action Plan, Equal Opportunity Employer, etc.).
 - Review General Conditions carefully as it details payment, retainage, and insurance requirements.
 Dane County retains 5% of the project until 50% of the project is complete. After 50% of the project is

complete, Dane County can remove retainage requirement or increase up to 10% depending on Contractor's schedule and quality of work.

- Site tour
 - Important to note the overhead electrical lines along CTH AB and ongoing WisDOT construction. WisDOT construction started in September 2022 with completion anticipated by November 2023.
