Base bid to include all slab on grade, footings, and retaining wall work, complete. This Deduct Alternate pertains to Sheets S101 and S303.

2. Section 32 31 19

Section Title: Decorative Metal Fences & Gates

Subsections 2.2, A.3. and 2.2.13.C.: Revise Panel Sections from 6' panel sections to 8' panel sections.

Subsection 2.2.7.A.: Revise picket spacing to 4" standard picket spacing.

Subsection 2.2.7.A. and 2.2.13.A.: Revise horizontal rail size to standard size of 1-7/16" x 1-1/2" minimum.

3. Sheets S101 and S303

Modify current Sheets S101 and S303 as follows: Revise Keynote 'A' to read: "DEDUCT ALTERNATE #1: REMOVE CONCRETE FOOTINGS AND CONCRETE WALLS AT LOCATIONS INDICATED BY KEYNOTE 'A'. BASE BID TO INCLUDE ALL CONCRETE SLAB ON GRADE, FOOTINGS AND RETAINING WALL WORK, COMPLETE."
