CHANGES TO BID FORM

CHANGES TO INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

2. Instructions to Bidders

1. GENERAL

- a) Add Paragraph "E. Construction activities must be coordinated with Dane County Law Enforcement Training Center Staff to ensure access to the site is maintained as required during project."
- b) Add Paragraph "F. The Engineer shall furnish red-top stakes every fifty (50) feet along driveway centerline and at the spot elevations shown on the Parking Lot Improvements Plan. Two hub with lath offsets will be provided to mark the storm sewer inverts every 50' along the storm sewer. Hub with lath offsets will be provided to outline the concrete pavements. Stakes will be provided once. The Contractor shall fine grade the aggregates and install storm sewer based on the stakes provided. Any re-staking of curb and gutter stakes shall be additionally billed to the Contractor at the standard hourly rate for a survey crew."


