## FAÇADE & PARAPET CAP SELECTIVE REMOVAL

This Addendum is issued to modify, explain or clarify the original Request for Bid (RFB) and is hereby made a part of the RFB. Please attach this Addendum to the RFB.

## PLEASE MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

## 1. Project Manual Cover Page

## 2. Bid Form

Delete current Bid Form; replace with new Bid Form, issued with this Addendum. Some scope of work clarification wording was added as well as an allowance for additional repairs.

## 3. Section 01 00 00

Page 2 - Items 1.2.A-C.: Delete the current paragraphs & insert the following:

- "A. Project Description: Perform the Work as specified and detailed in Construction Documents package. Contractor to provide construction services for the selective removal, storage & reinstallation (following structural investigation by the Engineer) of parapet caps and masonry façade panels. Contractor shall transport the panels to / from the Alliant Energy Center grounds for storage & construct a steel rack to accommodate angled upright storage of the façade panels. Additional repair work may be required before reinstalling façade panels:
  - 1. A monetary allowance is built into the project & bid to allow for this work. The Engineer and/or Owner shall detail these specific repairs to the Contractor.
  - 2. Specific & detailed accounting shall be required of the Contractor for this additional repair work including, but not limited to, time sheets, staff pay rates, & materials invoices (tax-free).

- B. The City-County Building was built in 1956. The Building is a seven story steel structure with concrete encased columns and beams (see photo 3C). Steel shelf angles anchored to the concrete beams at the floor levels support limestone panels on the building facades (see photos 3C, 3D and 4B). Embedded stainless steel bolts and plates were placed on the southwest façade to help retain the outward movement of the stone panels (see photos 1 and 2). These were added in the past & there are no records available of this modification. The bolts were placed approximately one foot above the shelf angle below the seventh floor of the building.
- C. Work by Owner:
  - 1. Temporary storage area for removed limestone façade panels is available at the Alliant Energy Center grounds. "

Page 3 - Item 1.6.C.: Delete the current paragraph & insert the following:"C. Schedule of Alternates: there are no alternates proposed for this project."

Page 9 - Item 1.36.A.: Delete the current paragraph & insert the following: "C. Not Applicable."

## 4. Sheet S-100

Delete current Sheet S-100; replace with new Sheet S-100, issued with this Addendum.

### FACADE PANEL AND PARAPET CAP SELECTIVE REMOVAL

HISTORY: THE CITY-COUNTY BUILDING WAS BUILT IN 1956. THE BUILDING IS A SEVEN STORY STEEL STRUCTURE WITH CONCRETE ENCASED COLUMNS AND BEAMS, SEE PHOTO 3C. STEEL SHELF ANGLES ANCHORED TO THE CONCRETE BEAMS AT THE FLOOR LEVELS SUPPORT LIMESTONE PANELS ON THE BUILDING FACADES, SEE PHOTOS 3C, 3D, AND 4B. AT SOME POINT IN THE BUILDINGS PAST, NO RECORDS AVAILABLE, EMBEDDED STAINLESS STEEL BOLTS AND PLATES WERE PLACED ON THE SOUTHWEST FACADE TO HELP RESTRAIN THE OUTWARD MOVEMENT OF THE STONE PANELS, SEE PHOTOS 1 AND 2, THE BOLTS WERE PLACED APPROXIMATELY ONE FOOT ABOVE THE SHELF ANGLE BELOW THE SEVENTH FLOOR OF THE BUILDING. AS STATED EARLIER, THE TIME OF THE PLACEMENT IS UNKNOWN AS IS THE CAUSE. THE PURPOSE OF THIS FACADE REMOVAL IS TO REVIEW THE CONDITION OF THE OF THESE PANELS, DETERMINE REQUIRED REPAIRS FOR THE PANELS AND/OR THE SUPPORT ANGLES AND DEVELOP A PLAN FOR THE REINSTALLATION OF THE PANELS.

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ACTION PLAN: FACADE PANELS AND PRECAST PARAPET CAPS ON THE SOUTH FACE OF THE CITY-COUNTY BUILDING ARE TO BE CAREFULLY REMOVED IN THE AREA INDICATED ON THE SITE PLAN. THE FACADE PANEL REMOVAL AREA IS ALSO SHOWN ON THE PHOTOS 1 AND 2. THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 45 PANELS INDICATED ON PHOTO ONE. FOLLOWING INSPECTION OF THE PANELS AND ANY REQUIRED REPAIRS, MODIFICATIONS, OR ALTERATIONS, THE PANELS AND PARAPET CAPS SHALL BE PLACED BACK IN THEIR PRESENT LOCATIONS. PLACE BACKER ROD AND MASTER SEAL NP2, OR EQUAL, IN JOINTS BETWEEN • REPLACED PANELS. THE PANELS ARE APPROXIMATELY 54" LONG, 26" HIGH AND 4" THICK. THEIR WEIGHT IS APPROXIMATELY 300 POUNDS PER PANEL. THE PRECAST CONCRETE PARAPET CAPS ARE TO BE REMOVED TO FACILITATE THE PANEL REMOVAL, SEE PHOTOS 5A, 5B, AND 5C. THE FACADE PANELS AND PARAPET CAPS SHALL BE STORED IN A DESIGNATED AREA OF THE SURFACE PARKING LOT AT THE COUNTY EXPO CENTER UNTIL THE TIME TO BE PLACED BACK ONTO THE BUILDING. THE MASONRY FRAME AROUND THE WINDOW SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE, SEE PHOTOS 3A, AND 3B. FOLLOWING REMOVAL OF THE PANELS, THE EXPOSED AREA OF THE WALL AND PANELS LEFT IN PLACE SHALL BE PROTECTED TO PREVENT DAMAGE AND WATER INFILTRATION UNTIL PANELS ARE TO BE REINSTALLED.
